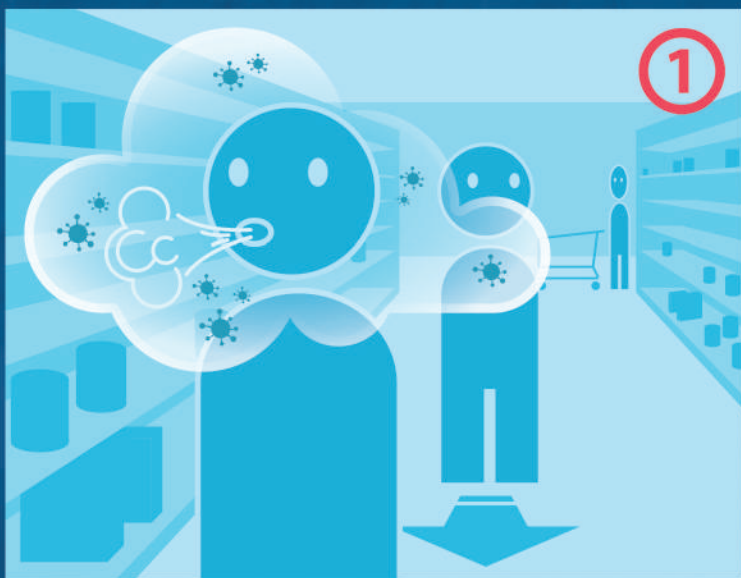


# How COVID Spreads



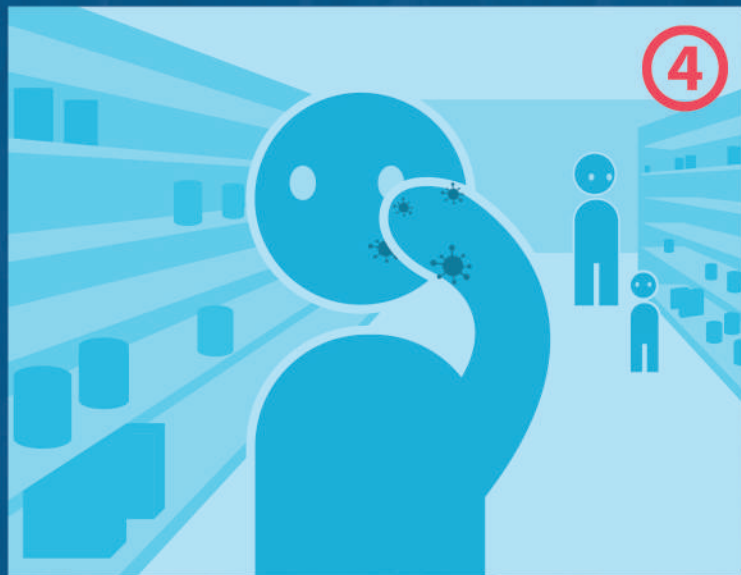
Pathogens suspended in droplets are expelled from the respiratory tract by talking, coughing or sneezing.



Pathogens remain suspended in the air before settling on to nearby surfaces.



Someone comes in contact with the surface and pathogen.



The individual then touches their face and the pathogen enters the body through the eyes, nose or mouth.
